Vendor Terms & Conditions

- The event will take place in downtown Everett on Saturday, October 2nd 12 -9 pm and Sunday, October 3rd 12-7 pm.
- Vendor booths must be open and staffed for the duration of the event.
- Vendors are responsible for PA or US Servsafe Certification and Sales Tax License, where applicable.
- Vendors are responsible for their own trash removal. Please leave the area as clean as you found it.
- Insurance, if desired, must be obtained at the vendor's own expense.
- Participants may begin set-up for the event at 11 am on Saturday, October 2nd and Sunday, October 3rd.
- Set-up: Vendors may drive up to unload. You must unload your items into your space as quickly as possible and move your vehicle from the vendor area to the vendor parking area before setting up.
- Break-down: Booths must be dismantled and ready to load before vehicles are brought into the vendor area.
- By signing the waiver, the exhibitor/participant completely agrees to comply with the terms and conditions of the event. Everett Free Library reserves the right to reject individuals who do not adhere to these terms and conditions.
